#### **Public Comment:**

 Charlie Cole stated that next Wednesday (5/8/2024) the Well Ordinance Committee will be holding a meeting at 7pm at the UMBT Township Building to discuss the final version of the well ordinance.

## Follow-Up from Last Meeting:

- Dohl shared his lessons learned from the *GIS for EAC Webinar* he attended:
  - Need to prioritize important projects, but potential uses include zoning, open space, etc.
  - Two online software options:
    - QGIS: Free
    - ArcGIS: \$120 for 2 years, plus \$1,000 for data (block credit package)
    - Some GIS Overlay information is free, but we may need to pay for others
  - There was discussion of if this could be used for wells, farm ponds, etc.
  - The Open Space board would support this.
    - Next Steps:
      - Financial Considerations: Need to map out costs and build a business case for usage.
      - Dohl to contact WeConserve to see if they could come speak with us
      - Alex to contact the county to inquire about their GIS capabilities
- EAC Website Discission
  - We need to decide on a name for the tab that will contain information on what we are doing
    - Cindy can add PDFs or links on blue tabs directly on the UMBT website
  - It was briefly discussed if we wanted our own email address, all members decided against this.
  - It was discussed if we wanted to create our own external website that could be linked on the UMBT website.
    - We would need to get permission from the supervisors.
    - Alex to make a prototype website to share at the next meeting for further discussion.
